

Duty and role

The duty and role of the umpire:

- As per Laws of
 Australian Football
 8.2.1 Field
 Umpires; The field
 Umpires shall have full
 control of and
 officiate a Match in
 accordance with these
 laws.
- The role of the umpire is to interpret and apply the laws of Australian Football within the spirit and intention of each law.

Academy Structure

- Develop junior umpires to officiate in the SMJFL.
- Umpires are categorised based on experience and ability:

Novice

- Less than one year umpiring
- Identified with red sweatbands

Intermediate

- More than one year umpiring
- Showing competency with foundations of umpiring
- Identified with **yellow** sweatbands

Experienced

- Identified as potential for senior football/regular U16 or 17 level football
- Identified with green sweatbands

Academy coaching team

- 14 appointed coaches/staff
- Inclusive of a qualified Strength & Conditioning coach

A few points to be mindful of:

- Like the Players, Umpires are learning too

Duty and role

The duty and role of the umpire:

• Club Volunteer Umpires have the same duty and role as any other umpire

Getting Started

Registration form has been distributed via Club Connect and email.

The registration form requires:

- WWCC
- Acknowledgement of a Code of Conduct

Appointments

Appointment publishings

- Umpire appointments are published weekly on the Friday before each Round
 - Mid-week matches will be published as soon as possible, prior to the match
 - If any concerns about non-appointment of Umpires, clubs will be contacted
- Appointments published on SMJFL Website via a live Google Doc
 - Teams should check appointments Saturday and Sunday morning in case any late changes

Finals Umpire Appointments

- SMJFL Umpiring Department endeavours to fill as many appointments as possible
- Goal Umpire appointments based on availability from senior leagues and Umpires who suitably fit the role
 - First week expect to be thin

UMPIRING DEPARTMENT – APPOINTMENT NO SHOW



The SMJFL will endeavour to appoint two (2) Field Umpires to each match. If only one (1) Field Umpire is appointed, it is not a requirement of the Clubs to appoint a second Field Umpire.

• Home Club shall provide a Field Umpire (if available) if the League appointed Umpire should request for assistance.

Where an SMJFL Umpire is absent or unable to complete a match and another member of the current SMJFL Umpires Department is not available, consistent with SMJFL By-Law 26:

- The teams involved may agree to appoint a substitute Field Umpire or Field Umpires who shall:
 - Officiate for the match
 - Have the power to lodge a report against a player or team official; and
 - Award SMJFL best and fairest votes for the match.

If no substitute Field Umpire(s) can be agreed upon the match shall be abandoned and the matter referred to the CEO for a determination regarding allocation of premiership points.

• A team Head Coach is not permitted to act as a Field Umpire.







Umpiring Staff

Coaches around the grounds

Umpiring Coaches will be around the grounds on match day to:

- Observe and provide feedback for Umpires
- They are not expected to provide operational assistance, outside of their coaching duties
- Team Managers can provide feedback
 - Provided it is done professionally and respectfully

2024 BY-LAWS



- Consistent with the SMJFL's 2022-2024 Strategic Plan and the leagues commitment to its values of Fun, Accountability, Integrity and Respect, our focus continues to be on delivering a fair and equitable competition.
- Draft 2024 Bylaws with track changes has been sent to Clubs.
- Clause 44 Appendix 4 Player Movement and Finals Qualification is currently being redrafted following the overwhelming support of Clubs to include reference to Restricted Player Lists (RPL's) from U13 U18 in season 2024
- A final draft of the Player Movement and Finals Qualifications Clause will be finalised and distributed on Friday 15 March
- "Clean" version of the 2024 SMJFL Bylaws will be distributed to Clubs and made available on the SMJFL website from 18 March





JUNIOR MATCH POLICY - UPDATES



Changes to SMJFL By-laws to align with AFL's Junior Match Policy, including:

- Ball Sizes (U8s Size I)
- New Age Groups (U8 and U9 Girls)
- Team Numbers (16 players for U12-U18 Girls Competitions)

Other changes that align with AFL's Junior Match Policy, include:

• Updated recommended Ground Size for modified competitions.

RESTRICTED PLAYER LISTS



- Clubs with multiple teams in any of the U13-U18 Age Groups are asked to provide a Restricted Player List to the SMJFL (Date TBC):
 - X number of players per team 18-a-side comp*
 - X number of players per team 16-a-side comp*
 - *Not required for the lowest ranked team
- Clubs required to "fill from below":
 - RPL players:
 - CAN play in a higher division
 - CAN play in a higher Age Group (if competition is ranked higher)
 - CAN'T play in a lower division
 - CAN'T play in finals in a team other than the team they are nominated on an RPL for
 - Non-RPL players:
 - CAN play in a maximum of two teams within an Age Group
 - However, 6-match rule still applies

2024 UNDERS PROGRAM



- Program running again in 2024
- 4-week transition program taking place immediately after the 2024 Auskick season (1st or 2nd week of August).
- Auskick centers create a team/s made up of Auskick participants eligible for under 8's in 2025. These teams will again be aligned to SMJFL clubs.

NOTE

Contact details of Unders participants are provided to Clubs following completion of program to help drive recruitment.

Over 75% of U8s participants in 2024 participated in the Unders program in 2023.

OPERATIONAL REQUIREMENTS – BEFORE THE GAME



Team Sheets

- Submit team selections before the match starts
- Both team lists will download once both teams have submitted
- Player **must** be removed from team sheet if they don't take the field

Venue Set Up

- Ensure ground markings are correct and visible
 - Boundary line at least three (3) metres from any potential obstacle
- Modified rules ground is set up according to SMJFL Rule Variation Matrix
- First match played at a venue must complete a Ground Inspection Report (link in Team Managers Handbook)
- Encouraged to set up a three (3) metre exclusion area around each team bench (no parents/spectators)

Equipment

- Must provide Goal Umpires with
 - Flags x 2, white coat, pen/pencil, score card
- Timekeepers to be provided with scorecards (Timekeeper specific)

Match Day Roles

• Ensure all roles are filled with accredited people (accreditations where applicable)

Umpires

 Meet Umpires and have two footballs ready of the appropriate specifications (according to SMJFL Rule Variation Matrix)





OPERATIONAL REQUIREMENTS – DURING THE GAME



Spectator Behaviour

• TM responsible for addressing issues involving their team's spectators (i.e. spectators towards Umpires)

Interchange Bench

- Only permitted officials allowed in team interchange bench area
 - o Coach, Assistant Coach, Coach Development Program (CDP) Junior Coach
 - Trainer
 - Runner
- Ensuring no one else enters that area (Team Manager included)
- Enforce three (3) metre exclusion area (if set up)

Umpires

• Check in with Umpires at half-time





OPERATIONAL REQUIREMENTS – AFTERTHE GAME



Duties

• TM to complete Competition Match Report (CMR).

Goal Umpires & Timekeeper Equipment

- Must collect and keep respective Goal Umpire Scorecards and Timekeeper Cards.
- Submit scores and other match statistics in PlayHQ by 9pm on the day of the match.

 This is also a requirement for Modified games

Injuries

• Injuries to be reported to Club.

Umpire

- TM name given to Umpires for CMR.
 - On the basis of confirming the details of the CMR (i.e. no reports, issues etc.)
- Club will be notified of any incidents / abuse by the Umpires / SMJFL Match Officials (discussed further in Incident Management session).

RISK MANAGEMENT – UNFIT GROUND



- Prior to commencement of play home team manager or ground manager must complete inspection of the ground and Ground Inspection Report be completed online.
- Where both team managers agree that the ground is unsafe
 - Attempts should be made to find alternative venue, in consultation with SMJFL staff
- If no alternative venue is found
 - Match will not proceed on fixtured day
 - May be rescheduled at the CEO's absolute discretion
- If no reschedule occurs
 - The match is abandoned
 - Premiership points will be split and no adjustment to teams' cumulative total points for and against





RISK MANAGEMENT – NO UMPIRE IN ATTENDANCE



- Where an SMJFL umpire is absent or unable to complete match:
 - Teams may agree to a substitute
 - A Head Coach is not permitted to umpire
 - If no substitute can be agreed upon the match will be abandoned and referred to CEO for premiership point allocation
- If I Field Umpire is appointed it is not a requirement for a club to provide a second umpire





RISK MANAGEMENT – INJURY STOPPED GAME W

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Where play is stopped because of an injury for a period of time equal to I quarter the following procedure applies:

- Where an alternate ground at the same venue is available, in suitable condition and agreed upon by Team managers
 - Play should continue the alternate oval at the same point which it was stopped.
- Where no alternate venue is immediately available (game stopped before half time):
 - Game abandoned
 - Premiership points shared
 - No adjustment to for and against scores
- Where no alternative venue is immediately available (game stopped after half time)
 - Game abandoned
 - Scores remain final

UNIQUE MATCH PROCESSES - HEAD COUNT



- If a team captain calls for a head count during play:
 - The field umpire requests a head count of the opposing team's players
 - Play must stop immediately
 - Timekeepers' clock must be stopped whilst the head count is taken
 - The timekeepers are to note the score on the scorecard
